Nwachuku has wide-ranging domestic and international banking experience in both the private and public sectors, including terms as vice president, NCB Development Corp., Washington, D.C.; credit department manager, National Cooperative Bank, Washington, D.C.; senior analyst, Midlantic National Bank (now PNC Bank), Edison, N.J.; and legal counsel, Federal Mortgage Bank, Sokoto, Nigeria.
