From 1997-2001, Stuart held the role of Debt Syndications and Placements leader for GE Capital - Capital Markets Services. From 2000-2002, he served as the Capital Markets Product Execution Leader, with responsibilities that included the U.S. Syndication, Private Placement, Securitization and Trade Finance activities of GE.
